### **GUIDELINES FOR EXHIBITORS**

- Application deadline: Postmarked no later than **April 1, 2010**.
- A jurying committee will review all packets for completed applications, including the category for judging, required number of photos submitted and quality of those photos and booth fee. Artists will be notified on **April 15, 2010** of their acceptance into the festival.
- Festival dates: Saturday – Sunday, May 22-23, 2010  
10:00 am – 5:00 pm both days
- Booth Fee - \$75. Check payable to Blairsville DDA. One artist per booth. Booth space will be 10 x 10. Artists will provide all materials needed for display – tent, tables, chairs, display racks, etc.
- Artist to submit 3 photographs of recent work and 1 photograph of booth set up, (photos will not be returned).
- All items displayed and sold must be original work of the artist exhibiting. (Reproductions of original work accepted, but should be limited.) No reselling of merchandise will be allowed.
- A minimum of \$500 cash prizes to be awarded at the festival.
- Event will take place rain or shine. Exhibitors are responsible for their own protective covering and securing of their booth space.
- Set up:
  - Friday evening 6:00 p.m. - 10:00 p.m.
  - Overnight Security from 10:00 p.m. Friday – 6:00 a.m. Saturday
  - Saturday morning 6:00 a.m. - 9:30 a.m.
  - Overnight Security from 6:00 p.m. Saturday to 9:00 a.m. Sunday.
- Exhibitor vehicles and equipment must be off the Square and out of the festival area no later than 9:30 a.m. Saturday. As you check in we will also discuss parking areas that are available.
- Exhibit must be open and manned continuously during Festival hours.
- Each exhibitor is responsible to pay their own Georgia State Sales Tax on their sales. Georgia Sales Tax in Union County is 7%.
- Tear down and removal of exhibit to be completed by 8:00 p.m. Sunday, May 23.
- Exhibitors are responsible for removing all debris from their booth area.
